### **Creating Public Value**

Creating public value is the purpose of public management.

Creating public value means:


- pursuing ultimate social outcomes that help establish justice and material wellbeing for each and for all.
- o deploying public assets through activities that create net positive effects.
- being accountable for these efforts to a public that is constantly debating,
   reimagining, and negotiating the terms of accountability in the realm of politics.

### **Creating Public Value (cont'd)**

Creating public value is NOT...

- "Achieving a mission"
  - Missions may be outmoded, narrowly or rigidly interpreted, or too vague.
- "Satisfying customers"
  - Citizens are not analogous to customers.
- "Maximizing outputs"
  - The causal connection between outputs and valued outcomes is often uncertain and untested.






### The Strategic Triangle






